DESCRIPTION

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain work area safety and orderly appearance.
- Road test vehicles when necessary to diagnose malfunctions and to ensure that they are working properly.
- Inspect braking systems, steering mechanisms, wheel bearings, hydraulics, and other important parts to ensure that they are in proper operating condition.
- Perform routine maintenance such as changing oil, checking batteries and lubricating equipment / machinery.
- Inspect and verify dimensions and clearances of parts to ensure conformance with factory specifications.
- Specialize in repair work and troubleshooting.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum of five (5) years practical experience with trucks and heavy construction equipment, required.
- Vocational / Technical certifications, beneficial.
- Specialized training and working experience in the diagnosis and troubleshooting of major components (engines and transmissions), OEM training, ASE certification and 608/609 certifications, preferred.
- Proficiency in the use of all tools of trade required, including welding equipment, diagnostic equipment, and power tools.
- Basic computer skills for data entry into maintenance systems.
- Ability to work in non-climate-controlled conditions required.
- Regular, predictable, full-time attendance is an essential function of the job.
- Willingness to work overtime – very important.
